The Reception and Nursery environments offer a spacious classroom for each year group which are well-planned to provide access to learning that supports all areas of the curriculum.

Admissions into Reception

If your child was born between 1/9/2016 and 31/8/2017 you must apply for a place in Reception Year before the 15th January 2021.

Admissions into Nursery

Please contact school office to add your child's name to our Nursery list. Admissions take place each term and children are offered a place once they have had their third birthday.

Our Nursery provides 15 hours provision per week and parents are offered either a morning or afternoon session depending upon numbers and places available.



Admissions Timeline

- ❑ November 2020 - Online admissions applications go live and hard copies are available from the council on request.

Parents are invited to name up to 5 preferred schools, ranked in order of preference.

- ❑ 15th January 2021 23:59 - Application deadline

- ❑ 16th April 2021 - Allocation Day

Parents who made applications online will be able to view their school allocation via the online admissions facility. Admissions will write to every applicant resident in Wolverhampton with notification of their allocated place.

- ❑ Parents will be required to respond to Wolverhampton City Council to any offers made within 10 working days.
