For your child's safety it is important that these rules are followed at all times:

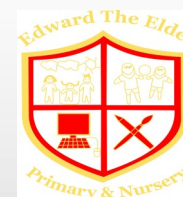
- No jewellery to be worn by children, except for small studs in the ears.
