



Year 3 Summer Term



Welcome back after the Easter break. We have an exciting term ahead of us!

Maths

Within Maths, we will be completing our Year 3 topics including; Measurement looking at Length and Perimeter, Time and Mass and Capacity. They will also be completing a unit of Fractions. The children will work on fluency in these topics and then their learning will move forward to problem solving and reasoning.

As ever, we will continue with a strong focus on times tables, and children will continue with Times Table Rockstars that will help children access all areas of learning within Maths. We continue to encourage the use of this at home also!

Children will also continue with arithmetic, which will continue to provide the basic calculation and mental skills required.

English

English learning will continue to have strong links to our thematic theme. They will be exploring a range of fiction and non-fiction texts which have different cultural focuses. The children will be building up to writing at length in their golden books and will be working on Year 3 writing skills that are expected to be including in their writing.



Science

In science, year 3 will start a new topic of 'Light' where the children will learn about light and properties of light as well as shadows. The children will be able to discuss that darkness is the absence of light and will be able to explain how shadows are formed.



Religious Education

The children will be looking at 'Why does the Prophet matter to Muslims?'

Thematic

Children will be starting a new theme in Thematic 'Around the World in 60 Days'. Thematic will have a strong focus of Geography this term but will also have links to History, Art and Music. The children will be exploring a range of countries and their cultures.

P.E

Children will be learning skills involved in striking and fielding, outdoor athletics, gymnastics and dance.

PSHE

Summer term will see a focus on Physical Health and Mental Wellbeing where the children will look at health choices and habits and what the effects of these can be. They will also be exploring feelings and different ways that these can be expressed.

Modern Foreign Languages

In MFL the children will be continue their new learning in French. French has already proven a hit and we can't wait to see their accents and pronunciation continue to improve!
