



Year 4 Summer Term

<p>Welcome back, we hope you had a relaxing and enjoyable Easter break! The first half term we will focus on History and art, followed by geography and design technology during the second half of the Summer term.</p>	<p>Religious Education</p> <p>The children will be continuing to learn about who is inspiring within the Sikh and Hindu faiths. They will also look at why Jesus is inspiring to Christians and look closely at places of worship.</p>
<p>Maths</p> <p>In Year 4 we will be continuing to focus upon number bonds linked to larger numbers. They will be building up their place value knowledge as well as continuing with the development of their times tables knowledge. We will continue to learn new methods linked to the four rules and then apply them to problem solving with an increased focus on times tables. They will begin to look at geometry and statistics.</p>	<p>Art</p> <p>In Art the children will be learning about 'Natural Art'. We will be using our environment to aid our learning. Our focus will be texture, line drawings, repeat patterns and colour. We will also be looking at comic strips where we will focus on our clay modelling skills.</p> <p>Geography</p> <p>Our topic for Geography will continue to be 'Asia', focusing on human geography and the impact this has on Asia.</p>
<p>English</p> <p>This term English will focus on writing playscripts, explanation texts, persuasive arguments, mythical stories and stories with dilemma.</p> <p>The children will be encouraged to use a variety of vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and punctuation (VCOP) to enable them to make their writing exciting, ensuring it engages the reader.</p> <p>We will continue to work on spelling, grammar and punctuation skills (SPAG) throughout the year during our daily OMS.</p>	<p>P.E</p> <p>This term the children will have a variety of PE taught by Soccer 2000 and Miss Jones.</p> <p>History</p> <p>Our topic for History will be continuing to look at aspects of 'Anglo Saxons' and 'Vikings'.</p> <p>Music</p> <p>We will be continuing to learn to play musical instruments this term focusing on the Ukulele, with a concert to celebrate their skills at the end of the term with Wolverhampton Music School.</p>
<p>Science</p> <p>In Science, the children will be learning about animals including humans with a focus on food chains, animal diets and digestion. They will then be progressing onto living things and their habitats looking at classification, food chains and food webs. The children will be carrying out experiments to explore this subject. They will have many opportunities to learn through investigations.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>The children will be developing their skills on a range of programmes. This half term we will be focusing on designing and presenting with ongoing learning surrounding internet safety.</p> <p>MFL</p> <p>In Year 4 the children will continue to learn Spanish. We will be looking at family members, animals and the children will have the chance to role play different Spanish experiences.</p>
