



Year 5 Summer



Welcome back after the Easter break. We hope that you all had an enjoyable holiday! This term our new curriculum topics are 'South America' focusing on the human impact on the continent and 'Crime and Punishment'.

Maths

In mathematics, we will be spending more learning time on geometry: focusing on angles, 2D/3D shapes and manipulating shapes through translation and reflection. We will be recapping on perimeter and area of shapes before moving on to finding volume. Again, children will be given opportunities to apply their knowledge of the four rules of number through a range of rich problem solving activities.

Alongside maths lessons, children will also be taking part in arithmetic lessons where they will hone their mental and written skills in weekly practice assessments.

English

In English we will start with a unit based on the book *Street Child* set in Victorian times. Children will also continue to improve their grammatical knowledge and receive weekly spellings, so that they are well prepared for Year 6. Children will be studying a range of fiction and non-fiction texts covering different genres. We will also be encouraging children to write extended pieces of work in order to prepare for the expectations of Year 6.

Science

Children will also be studying the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. As well as all this, they will learn about reproduction in some plants and animals. Pupils will also learn about develop their understanding of animal habitats. Children will be given a range of opportunities to work scientifically throughout the Summer term.

MFL

Children will continue to learn Spanish building on their vocabulary and understanding. They will develop their Spanish conversation skills as well as learning to read and write in Spanish.

Religious Education

In RE, pupils will learn about how different religions can teach us how to deal with temptation. They will learn how key figures from different faiths resisted temptations and how to make the right choices.

D&T

In design and technology, we will be focusing on food technology. This will see children learning about healthy foods, safety in the kitchen and food hygiene, as well as preparing simple sandwich-based recipes.

Art

In art, we will be focusing on Tie Dye, looking at British design from the 20th century. They will be exploring the different fashions from the 1960s and will be designing and creating their own tie-dye t-shirt.

P.E

This term, Soccer 2000 will continue to teach P.E in Year 5. Children will be developing a variety of skills in games such as cricket and rounders and then move onto athletics. They will also continue to have dance with Miss Jones.

Geography

Children will learn about South America. Our Geography based topic looking closely at the human impact on the rain-forest and slums in Rio De Janeiro.

History

This term's History focus is Crime and Punishment. Children will discover how people were punished in the past and compare this with present day.

Music

As musicians the children will be learning about song writing. This will give children the opportunity to write their own lyrics and music.

Computing

In computing we will continue to learn about e-safety. We are also investigating different coding software and experimenting with programming using a range of software and hardware.
