Maths

Science

Following the successful topic of **Evolution and Inheritance** in Science, the children will now move onto the 'Living Things and their Habitats' and 'Animals, including Humans'. Children will also be participating in some Science investigations after SATs, in order for children to demonstrate their scientific knowledge and understanding further!

Religious Education

The children will be looking at the importance of values and answering the question: 'What matters most?' The children will be researching and comparing values between Humanists and Christianity and identifying values that they hold within themselves.

P.E

This term we will continue with dance taught by Miss Jones, as well as Soccer 2000. We will be preparing dances for our leavers' performance as well as learning athletics skills ahead of sports day.

Music

As musicians the children will be learning to accompany their songs with increasingly complex percussion instruments and rhythms.
